**League Rules, General Information, Forms**

**Team Roster, Eligibility**

1. Fifteen (15) members per team maximum, minimum of twelve (12) players.
2. Team rosters due by **Nov. 19, 2010**. Players may not be added once roster is determined.
3. Academic and behavioral requirements determined weekly.
4. Child must provide proof of medical insurance and permission of parent or guardian to participate in league play.
5. Student/players must maintain a “C” average overall, with no “U”s in any area or in conduct, in order to remain eligible for league play. If a student/player is not maintaining a “C” average, he/she must sit out a game and will be placed on academic probation. Academic probation will last for a period of three (3) weeks. If the player’s grades improve, he/she will be restored to full eligibility. However, if grades do not improve, the student will automatically be suspended from the team. If a student/player receives an unsatisfactory conduct grade on a progress report, he/she will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) weeks. If a student/player receives a conduct referral, he/she must sit out for that week’s game.
6. If a student/player has three (3) unexcused absences during the interim or regular grading period, the student/player must sit out the next game and will be put on a three (3) week suspension.

**Playing Time Requirements**

1. Each player must play a minimum of one (1) quarter (6 Minutes) of the game.
2. No player will play more than two (2) quarters (12 Minutes) for the entire game.
3. Substitutions may only occur at the beginning of a quarter or at the 3-minute mark of each quarter. The clock will stop at the 3:00 minute mark of each quarter to allow for substitutions. Play will continue with the clock stopped until the next dead ball. At this point, substitutions can be made. Exception: A substitution may occur at any point in order to replace an injured player.
4. Each team must provide a Score Keeper for each game. The team Score Keeper designated as the home team on the schedule will serve as the Official Scorebook. Along with keeping stats such as fouls, points, timeouts, etc., Score Keepers will also track playing time for each player. Game officials will be instructed to allow Score Keepers the opportunity at the start of each quarter and at each 3-minute break to record the players playing in that designated 3-minute period. Score sheets will be provided to easily keep track of each player’s playing time.
5. The coach may determine who plays during any overtime period. Players may play beyond the allotted two-quarter maximum.

6. If a team has less than ten (10) players available or eligible at any game, they may be subject to penalties. It shall be determined the reason for absences or ineligibility of the players. The school must provide proof. If no proof is provided, the game will be considered a forfeit in the standings with the winning team receiving a plus 15 points and the forfeiting team receiving a minus 15. However, the game will be played.

### **Game Rules**

1. Ten (10) academic questions, five (5) for each team, will be asked at the start of each game. One point will be awarded for each correct answer.
2. Ball Size: 28.5
3. Four six (6) minute quarters.
4. The clock will stop on all dead balls.
5. The clock will stop at the 3:00 minute mark of each quarter to allow for substitutions. Play will continue with the clock stopped until the next dead ball. At this point, substitutions can be made. Games are divided into 8 3-minute periods to allow for substitutions to be made and monitored easily.
6. Zone defense may be used.
7. Full court pressing is allowed.
8. No pressing is allowed when a team is up by 10 or more points. The team that is down by 10 or more points may press. When the lead goes below 10 points, the team that is up may resume pressing.
9. If a team is up by 20 points or more during the fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) quarter, the starters from the team with a 20-point lead or more must come out of the game. Starters may return if the lead is 15 points or less and continue to play until the lead reaches 20 points or more.
10. Five (5) minute halftime.
11. Two (2) 60-second timeouts per half per team. No carryover.
12. Overtime period – two (2) minutes.
13. One (1) additional 60-second timeout per team will be granted for overtime periods. Any unused timeouts from the second half may **not** be carried over to the overtime period.

### **Coach / Player / Fan Sportsmanship**

In any competitive sporting venue, lively conversations and debates will occur. That is part of the game. The intent of rules concerning sportsmanship is to insure that players, coaches, fans, officials and facility personnel are participating in a safe environment.

#### 1. Technical Fouls

##### ➤ Coaches

- ❑ 1<sup>st</sup> Technical Foul: The first technical foul that a coach receives during a game will require that coach to remain seated on the bench for the remainder of the game.
- ❑ 2<sup>nd</sup> Technical Foul: A coach receiving a second (2<sup>nd</sup>) technical foul at any point during league play must leave the court and facility at that point and will receive a one (1) game suspension from league play. The one game suspension will apply to the next scheduled game. The

suspended coach may not be present in the facility during his/her suspended game or any other scheduled games being played.

- 3<sup>rd</sup> Technical Foul: A coach receiving three (3) technical fouls during league play will be suspended for the remainder of league play and cannot be present in the facility for any league games.

➤ Players

- 1<sup>st</sup> Technical Foul: The first technical foul that a player receives will result in that player suspended from play for the remainder of the quarter in which the technical foul is assessed and from the next quarter of play or overtime period.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Technical Foul: A player receiving a second (2<sup>nd</sup>) technical foul at any point during league play will be suspended from play for the remainder of the game in which the technical foul is called and from the next scheduled league game.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Technical Foul: A player receiving three (3) technical fouls during league play will be suspended from the remainder of league play.

➤ Fans

- All game officials and the league coordinator have the authority to remove unruly fans from the facility. Any fan that is removed from the facility will be banned from the facility for the remainder of league play.
- Should a fan refuse to leave the facility when asked, local authorities will be called to escort them from the premises.

**General Information (Subject to change depending upon teams entering)**

1. Each team will play eleven (11) regular league games plus a minimum of one (1) tournament game.
2. Game times for league and tournament play will be 6:15pm and 7:30pm for Thursday games and 6:15pm and 7:45pm for Friday games.
3. The seeded tournament will be played out to 6<sup>th</sup> place. Quarter Final losers will play for 5<sup>th</sup> Place, Semi-Final Losers for 3<sup>rd</sup>.
4. A Champion and Runner-Up trophy will be presented to the first and second place teams.
5. All participating players and coaches, cheer and dance team members and sponsors will receive a league t-shirt. Team contacts/coaches should provide needed t-shirt sizes to Mid-America Sports Center no later than Friday January 28, 2011.
6. T-Shirts will be distributed the first round of tournament play.
7. **All League Team:** Individual trophies will be presented to an All League Team consisting of twenty players at the conclusion of the Championship game Mar. 18. The All League Team will be selected by the coach from each participating team, selecting two players from their team. Coaches should submit their selections by Friday Feb. 25.
8. Players selected to the All League Team will participate in a game **Friday March 25, 2011 at 6:30pm**. Coaches from the First and Second Place finishers in tournament play will coach the game. The league administrator and coaches will select teams from the 20 members of the All League Team.

9. League and tournament schedules will be posted on the MidAmerica Sports Center website at <http://www.midamericasportscenter.com>. Schedules will also be posted on Court B at MidAmerica.
10. League play results and standings will be posted on the MidAmerica website beginning the week of Dec. 13 and updated weekly through tournament play. Standings will also be posted on Court B at MidAmerica.
11. Final league standings will determine tournament seeding based upon winning percentage during league play.
  - **Two-Way Tie**: The first tie-breaker is head-to-head competition. If teams have split head-to-head play, the team with the total highest accumulated winning margin during league play is the higher seed. The most points credited for a win is +15 and for a loss –15. If a tie still exist after using the established point system, seeding will be determined by a coin flip between the two teams.
  - **Three-Way tie or more**: The first tie-breaker is the established point system. Any two-way ties from that point will first go to head-to-head competition. If a tie still exist, seeding will be determined by a coin flip between the two teams.
12. Admission: Players, Two Coaches, Cheerleaders and Two Cheer Coaches – No Charge. Fans: \$3 Adults, \$1 Seniors and Students, Free – Children 6 & under. Note: \$1 from each Adult admission will be deposited into account that will be divided equally among all participating schools.
13. **Player and Cheer Rosters along with \$300 entry fee should arrive at MidAmerica Sports Center no later than Friday Nov. 19.
